Since they did not know the righteousness that comes from God and sought to establish their own, they did not submit to God's righteousness. **Romans 10:3**

Moses describes in this way the righteousness that is by the law: "The man who does these things will live by them." Romans 10:5

Keep my decrees and laws, for the man who obeys them will live by them. I am the Lord. **Leviticus 18:5**

But the righteousness that is by faith says: "Do not say in your heart, 'Who will ascend into heaven?'" (that is, to bring Christ down) Romans 10:6

"or 'Who will descend into the deep?'" (that is, to bring Christ up from the dead).

Romans 10:7

But what does it say? "The word is near you; it is in your mouth and in your heart," that is, the word of faith we are proclaiming: Romans 10:8

No, the word is very near you; it is in your mouth and in your heart so you may obey it. **Deuteronomy 30:14**

For it is with your heart that you believe and are justified, and it is with your mouth that you confess and are saved. Romans 10:10

As the Scripture says, "Anyone who trusts in him will never be put to shame." For there is no difference between Jew and Gentile—the same Lord is Lord of all and richly blesses all who call on him, for, "Everyone who calls on the name of the Lord will be saved." Romans 10:11-13
