Murder in California

- Death penalty suspended by Gavin Newsom
- Currently, 650 individuals on death row
- 2,197 murders in California in 2022 alone

Precautions is prescribing the death penalty God gave in the Old Testament

- Testimony of 2 or 3 witnesses—Deut. 19
- More than one judge needed—Exod. 20:32
- No partiality to the rich—Exod. 23:6-7
