

The Name Above Every Other Name

Philippians 2:1-11

If you have any encouragement from being united with Christ, if any comfort from his love, if any fellowship with the Spirit, if any tenderness and compassion,

Philippians 2:1

then make my joy complete by being like-minded, having the same love, being one in spirit and purpose. **Philippians 2:2**

Do nothing out of selfish ambition or vain conceit, but in humility consider others better than yourselves. **Philippians 2:3**

Your attitude should be the same as that of Christ Jesus: Who, being in very nature God, did not consider equality with God something to be grasped,

Philippians 2:5-6

but made himself nothing, taking the very nature of a servant, being made in human likeness. And being found in appearance as a man, he humbled himself and became obedient to death— even death on a cross!

Philippians 2:7-8

Therefore God exalted him to the highest place and gave him the name that is above every name, that at the name of Jesus every knee should bow, in heaven and on earth and under the earth,

*and every tongue confess that Jesus Christ is Lord, to the glory of God the Father. **Philippians 2:11***

Five Truths about the Name of Jesus

1. Jesus' Name is Power.

*In the beginning was the Word, and the Word was with God, and the Word was God. He was with God in the beginning. Through him all things were made; without him nothing was made that has been made. **John 1:1-3***

Jesus was powerful from the beginning of Creation.

2. The Name of Jesus is a Sacrificial Name.

*“Nazareth! Can anything good come from there?” **John 1:46***

“Is not this the carpenter’s son?”

Matthew 13:55

“Foxes have holes and birds of the air have nests, but the Son of Man has no place to lay his head.”

3. The Name of Jesus is a Conquering Name.

“at the name of Jesus every knee will bow.” Philippians 2:10

This is the victory that has overcome the world, even our faith. 1 John 5:4

Out of his mouth comes a sharp sword with which to strike down the nations. “He will rule them with an iron scepter.” He treads the winepress of the fury of the wrath of God Almighty. On his robe and on his thigh he has this name written: KING OF KINGS AND

LORD OF LORDS.

4. The Name of Jesus is an Exalted Name.

Therefore God exalted him to the highest place and gave him the name that is above every name,
Philippians 2:9
