Our Responsibility to Government as Christians

Christian Citizenship towards Government

Everyone must submit himself to the governing authorities, for there is no authority except that which God has established. The authorities that exist have been established by God.

Romans 13:1

1. The Government system originates with God.

Where do you come from?" he asked Jesus, but Jesus gave him no answer. "Do you refuse to speak to me?" Pilate said. "Don't you realize I have power either to free you or to crucify you?"

John 18:9-10

Jesus answered, "You would have no power over me if it were not given to you from above.
Therefore the one who handed me over to you is guilty of a greater sin." John 18:11

Then Daniel praised the God of heaven and said: "Praise be to the name of God for ever and ever; wisdom and power are his. He changes times and seasons; he sets up kings and deposes them.

2. Functions God has ordained for Government

2. To protect its citizens

Ecclesiastes 8:11

For he is God's servant to do you good. But if you do wrong, be afraid, for he does not bear the sword for nothing. He is God's servant, an agent of wrath to bring punishment on the wrongdoer.

Romans 13:4

3. Government is given an awesome authority to carry out its function, even to the taking of life.

Biblical Principle: When you take another person's life, you forfeit your right to live.

"Whoever sheds the blood of man, by man shall his blood be shed; for in the image of God has God made man. **Genesis 9:6**

Our responsibility to the Government

1. Obedience to the law.

Everyone must submit himself to the governing authorities, Romans 13:1

For rulers hold no terror for those who do right, but for those who do wrong. Do you want to be free from fear of the one in authority? Then do what is right and he will commend you. Romans 13:3

Therefore, it is necessary to submit to the authorities, not only because of possible punishment but also because of conscience.

Romans 13:5

Peter and the other apostles replied: "We must obey God rather than men! Acts 5:29

Open defiance of the law should take place only when the state commands something that directly violates scripture.

We should be prepared to openly accept the consequences of our disobedience.

so that you may become blameless and pure, children of God without fault in a crooked and depraved generation, in which you shine like stars in the universe as you hold out the word of life—

Philippians 2:15-16
