New and mature Christians

Priscilla and Acquila,
mature believers
Greet Priscilla and Aquila, my
fellow workers in Christ Jesus. They
risked their lives for me. Not only I
but all the churches of the Gentiles
are grateful to them. Greet also
the church that meets at their
house. Romans 16:3-5a

Epenetus,
mature believer
Greet my dear friend Epenetus,
who was the first convert to Christ
in the province of Asia.

Andronicus and Junias, mature believers

Greet Andronicus and Junias, my relatives who have been in prison with me. They are outstanding among the apostles, and they were in Christ before I was.

Romans 16:7

Apelles,
a mature believer
Greet Apelles, tested and approved
in Christ. Romans 16:10a

 Aristocrats and slaves, rich and poor

Aristobulus, close to Emperor Claudius

Greet those who belong to the household of Aristobulus.

Romans 16:10b

Narcissus, wealthy secretary to Emperor Claudius Greet Herodion, my relative. Greet those in the household of Narcissus who are in the Lord.

Jews and Gentiles

Romans 16:11

Timothy, my fellow worker, sends his greetings to you, as do Lucius, Jason and Sosipater, my relatives.

Romans 16:21

Tertius, a slave

I, Tertius, who wrote down this letter, greet you in the Lord.

Romans 16:22

Gaius, wealthy landowner, where church met

Gaius, whose hospitality I and the whole church here enjoy, sends you his greetings.

Romans 16:23

Erastus and Quartus,
City Director and a slave

Erastus, who is the city's director of public works, and our brother Quartus send you their greetings.

Romans 16:23b

Greet one another with a holy kiss. All the churches of Christ send greetings. **Romans 16:16**

Shake hands warmly with each other. All the churches here send you their greetings.
