Revelation 19

1. The author asserts that, “when we get to heaven, we will all be doing a lot of shouting, bowing, praising, and lifting our hands to the One who saved us and called us to be part of the family of God.” According to Revelation 19:1, 3, 4, 6—What will the voices of a great multitude be crying out?

2. “As this chapter begins, the Holy Spirit is bringing the reader up to speed with what just happened in order to transition into the amazing events that are about to take place.” What form does Revelation 19:10-5 take? What is once again happening in heaven?

3. “God's righteous judgments have come. The great harlot is dead.” However, there is still “that huge Armageddon army lurking out there with the devil, the Antichrist, and the false prophet”. While the Returning Messiah takes care of this battle, what is our job as, “His servants and those who fear Him”?

4. The next major happening, is the second coming of Christ. Three important questions determine how a person will interpret the rest of this chapter. What are they?

5. Which view of the millennium believes in a, “literal kingdom in which Jesus will reign from Jerusalem for 1,000 years.”

6. Which view of the millennium believes that, “This period will begin at the conclusion of the tribulation, when Jesus returns. At that time, God will pour out His Holy Spirit upon the Jewish nation. The Jews will recognize Jesus as their Messiah and will individually give themselves to the Lord”?

7. What does Romans 11:26 say will happen when the Holy Spirit moves the hearts of an entire nation?

8. What promise for a new covenant with Israel, is given in Jeremiah 31:31?

9. Do the post-millennialists and amillennialism believe in a literal interpretation of the Bible? A biblical literalist believes that, “Jesus Christ will physically reign from a physical throne in the physical city of Jerusalem on this physical earth.”

10. Does this scenario fit the overall context of prophecy and the character of God?

11. Does the repetition of the phrase "thousand years" in the future-focused narrative of the next chapter of Revelation seem to support a literal 1,000 years or a non-literal 1000 year period?

13. What do they sing in Revelation 19:6-10?
14. What is the "marriage of the Lamb" and how does John 14:2-3 refer to this reunion?
15. What does the "marriage supper of the Lamb" refer to?
16. While striving for holiness is part of what demonstrates genuine faith, whose responsibility does Paul say it is to make the Church worthy enough to be the Bride of Christ in Ephesians 5:25-27?
17. When does this marriage occur? And what guarantee has the Lord given during this engagement period according to Ephesians 1:13-14?
18. After the rapture will come the marriage and the judgment seat of Christ. Is that a time of judgment for reward? Or is it an adjudication about heaven or hell?

20. What is He called in Revelation 3:14?
21. How are His eyes described in Revelation 1:14?
22. What is unique about His robe according to Isaiah 63:2?

25. How is His governance or rule described in Psalm 2:8-9; Revelation 12:5?
26. What is He called in 1 Timothy 6:15?
27. What is Timothy's "Good Confession" found in 1 Timothy 6:13-16?
28. How is Jesus' Second Coming to earth different from the first time He came?
29. Who will return with Him? Who are the "armies of heaven" that ride at His back? Are they angelic beings like the ones Elisha saw during the siege of Dothan (2 Kings 6)? Revelation 19:8, 14 give us a hint.
